We are writing to update you on some of the recent developments TSIMCO has been working on to better serve our community. As always, thank you for your support and understanding as we work together to benefit the community.








Figure 1. Sound Dampening Chute #1; Figure 2. Sound Dampening Trommel House; Figure 3. Sound Dampening Chute #1 & #2 shown from below the Trommel House.

#### **NOISE REDUCTION**

I'm pleased to report we have successfully enclosed the trommel portion of our nonferrous recycling operations, and this has reduced the noise from our operations. We are continuing our noise reductions efforts. We are installing rubber-lined noise dampening chutes, and we have installed two of the three chutes we are fabricating. These installations should be complete by the end of summer. We apologize for the delay in installation, but these installations must be coordinated with maintenance outages for safety.

### AIR QUALITY CONCERNS

First, we have conducted an air quality test in the ball field property we own in the community. We want to reassure the community that the test results were great! We were below the detectable limits for any pollutant and well below the standard for any health or safety concerns. We have also coordinated with the Arkansas DEQ. They have inspected our plant and reviewed these results as well, finding no concerns. Since April, we have temporarily moved our cutting area farther away from the neighborhood. We want your feedback to confirm this has helped, so we can determine if this needs to be a permanent relocation. Please respond to the survey at the end of this update, so we can ensure that this is the most helpful approach.


### IRON MOUNTAIN JOB FAIR




Figure 3-5. Ozan Inghram Iron Mountain Neighborhood Center Career Fair
